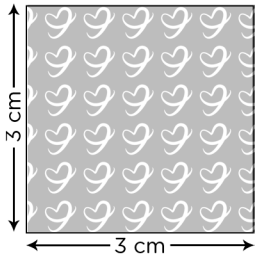

#### Tips for choosing the ring to measure:

- All fingers are different. Measure specifically a ring that you feel comfortable with on the finger in question. Comfortably it is very subjective, there are people who like it tighter and others less. My advice is that you choose a size that is tight enough so that it does not fall off, but loose enough so that it goes in and out at the knuckle.
- The size of the finger changes depending on the time of day and the weather. For best results, try on the sample ring at the beginning and end of the day (to see if your fingers have changed a lot), and when your hands are warmer or colder (they expand in the heat).
